Agenda & Objectives

Over the two days YAC attendees will cover the following:

- Corporate Governance, leadership & training
- Facilitated group workshops to discuss & develop strategies for educating & engaging the next generation
- Overview of Government's position on its investment in the training for producers, next generation & women farmers
- Presentation sessions providing delegates the opportunity to access latest industry information & how this will impact agriculture long term.

Daily set up

Thursday 2 September will consist of 3 x 20minute presentations from key note speakers. Following the presentations attendees will have a Q & A opportunity with speakers for 30 minutes, followed by a facilitated group discussion on how best to disseminate information back to their individual groups.

Representatives will then tour nearby industry body venues in Melbourne to gain an insight into corporate operations and how they relate to the ground level agricultural industry.

A formal dinner will be held that evening to allow representatives the opportunity to further develop their industry networks. FFN will host the evening and an inspiring and successful individual from within agriculture has been invited as the guest speaker to address the dinner.

Friday 3 September will begin with 3 x 50 minute breakout sessions focusing on leadership, corporate governance and regulation requirements. Breakout session leaders will provide information through a set presentation and general discussion with representatives.

Following the breakout sessions, all representatives will gather to hold a symposium to brainstorm ways to build a collective approach to encourage and support the next generation of agriculture through the entire supply chain and in all facets of the industry. A twelve month blue print including key performance indicators, will be developed to allow groups to measure their ongoing success.
